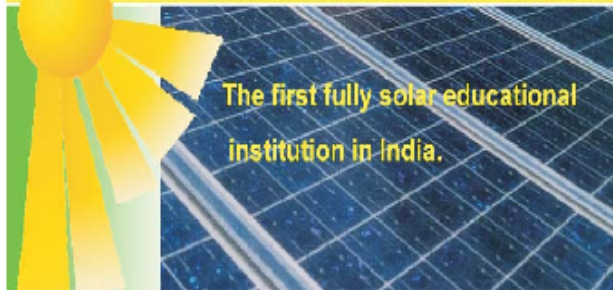


Renewable Energy Centre Mithradham
